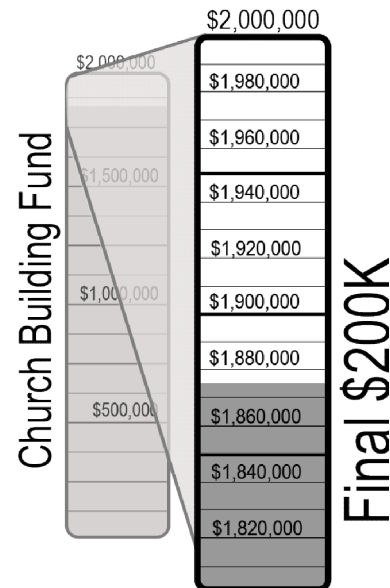
For our young worshipers: Children's Sabbath bags are available in the Cradle Roll room for your use during church. Children's activity pages are at the welcome desk.
